Jakarta Tech Talks	We think it would make the most sense to make JakartaOne a subdomain of the main Jakarta EE website (for example: jakartaone.jakarta.ee).
	This would help unify the brand and make it really clear that JakartaOne is an official part of Jakarta EE. Especially since we're planning to rebrand JakartaOne to include all kinds of Jakarta events: JakartaOne (rebrand) tech talks, livestreams, JUG tours, and F2F events in China, Japan, and other regions.
	By keeping it under the jakarta.ee domain, we can:
	<ul> <li>Strengthen SEO for the main Jakarta EE site by consolidating authority.</li> <li>Make navigation easier and more consistent for users.</li> <li>Capture and channel traffic from these event pages directly back to Jakarta EE's core content and resources.</li> </ul>
	We think this approach will help us drive all of that event traffic back to the main site over time, supporting overall awareness and adoption goals for Jakarta EE.
	Our webdev team can help migrate the content to the new URL.

The only technical consideration is that we need to ensure we setup wildcard redirects so that any request to jakartaone.org are automatically redirects to jakartaone.jakarta.ee.
