 - Desire to expand the ballot process beyond Wayne
 - Agreed

 - Specification documents must start with "jakarta" (jakarta-messaging-spec-1.2.3.pdf)
 - TCK binaries must start with "jakarta" (jakarta-messaging-tck-1.2.3.zip)
 - Specifications in Jakarta EE 9 are welcome to make this change now, but not required
 - Action Item: templates will need to be updated (Scott Stark)
- TCK Promotion discussion that did not conclude
 - "TCKs not getting promoted" raised twice during Steering Committee
 - Not clear if there are any gaps here
