    - A question came up about the licensing of their Compatible Implementation
      - If the Eclipse Foundation Board approves LGPL-2.1, are we okay with it being added to the current list of: EPL-2.0, APACHE-2.0, MIT, BSD-3-Clause?
        - LGPL requires you to publish any changes made
        - Ed Bratt's comment: historically not preferred
