 - Resolved that the Jakarta EE Working Group co-create and join <u>cn4j-alliance@eclipse.org</u> list to facilitate discussions on formation of a CN4J Alliance with the MicroProfile Working Group.
 - <u>cn4j-alliance@eclipse.org</u> -- will be an open and archived e-mail list
 - The resolution was passed without objection.
- Draft resolution for discussion by both MPWG and Jakarta EE WG on forming the alliance (see previous)
- We will request Scott Stark post his starting PDF from Nov. 24th to the new list, once the resolution has been passed by MPWG Steering Committee.
- Further actions deferred until we have resolutions passed in both committees.
- Following points to be deferred to a future discussion
 - Identify specific technical next step(s), e.g. one of the following:
 - How Jakarta consumes MicroProfile specifications
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 - Need for new profiles that better align MicroProfile with Jakarta
 - How lifecycle differences are dealt with
 - How backwards compatibility issues are defined and marketed
 - Identify marketing next step(s), e.g. one of the following
 - Formalize brand
 - Messaging for CN4J
 - Announcement or rollout plan

Marketing Committee Update

- Neil was not present. Karen presented a summary of the Marketing Team (Minutes from last week's Marketing committee).
- Highlighted high-level plan review and budget items.
- Also, referred to discussion about Collateral Repository and SEO progress report.
