Jakarta EE 12

- Update from Jared or James if present
 - There were few updates.
 - Work is proceeding.
 - Some projects with minimal active members are successfully voting in new members
- Schedule and milestone dates going forward
 - M3 Feb 15 to Mar 31
 - M4 Apr 1 to May 15
 - M5 May 16 to Jun 30 – possibly Core profile here
 - M6 Jul 1 to Aug 15
 - M7 Aug 15 to Sep 30 – ideally we release here or soon after
 - M8 Oct 1 to Nov 15
- Jared and James provided an update
 - There has been no pushback to the dates above.
 - Specs with the most work are Jakarta Data and Jakarta Persistence.
 - Jakarta REST work has begun.
 - Working to add committers to the Yasson project. (Committer elections have been restarted and hopefully will succeed.)
- Discussion about compatible implementation readiness for EE 12 – core profile
 - GlassFish would not be ready until the end of the year, at the earliest.
 - Discussed readiness of other potential core profile implementations. Both WildFly and OpenLiberty are still working on EE 11 Platform releases. Core Profile initial compatible implementation has not yet been identified. The mid-year goal for Core Profile release is potentially at risk. (both the Core Profile as well as the requisite component initial compatible implementations.)

Project Staffing Gaps

- Discuss actions, if any, following the discussion we held last meeting.
- Ed volunteered to reach out to Ondro and see if he has any thoughts or ideas about this.

E-mail voting proposal

- Per the discussion from our discussions is first and foremost, a need to increase engagement, especially from our Asia/Pac committee members
- Discussion – how can we achieve greater engagement from committee members?
 - Should we have an explicit vote about this resolution?
 - We found it challenging to discuss without the main sponsor present.
 - Cesar will work with David to resolve the established commentary in the proposal.
- One proposal is to work to close this out by establishing a best practice guide for this committee to vote on resolutions.

- At David Blevin's prodding, Tanja suggested kicking off an e-mail thread about Jakarta EE Long Term Roadmap.
 - A discussion was started under the subject "Enabling more email discussion and email voting" but engagement was limited and there was none from members that cannot join the meetings in person.

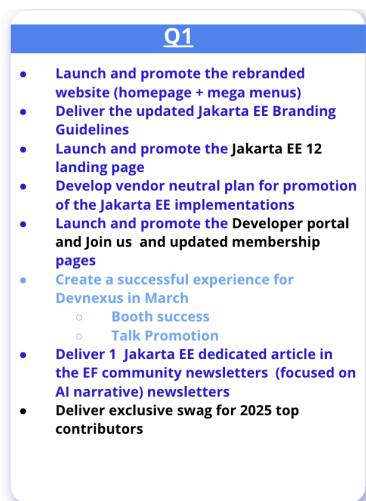
Deliver Future Jakarta EE Specification Releases

- Report on membership status, activity and success

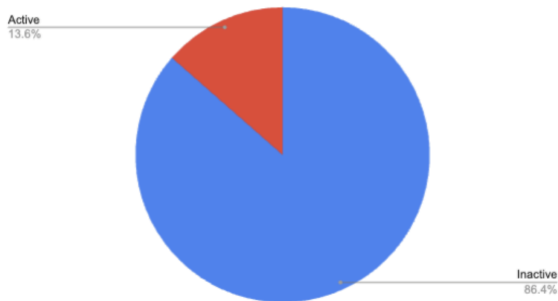
Jakarta EE long-term roadmap

Jakarta EE Membership Fees and Charter update

- Tanja suggests postponing this discussion. So far we have the following proposals:
 - EF proposal: Membership fees change to Euros, which includes about 15% increase
 - IBM proposal: Membership fees change to Euros with various changes on the membership fees (e.g. decrease for Strategic members, increase for Participant members)
 - Another option that was mentioned is Membership fees change to Euros, but the the fee value approximately stay the same (using avg. 2025 exchange rate)
 - Fee increase is discussed separately and afterwards
