- Christopher Guindon joined to present a proposal to eliminate recent problems we are seeing with bot traffic and DDoS attacks targeting a preview URL
 - Propose migrating the website jakarta.ee to the EF infrastructure.
 - How big was the effort? Fairly easy.
 - The website address will not change.
 - This work will not incur additional spending, in fact this change is a result of the charge increases we are seeing from Netlify, and this will control the cost, and provide equivalent service.

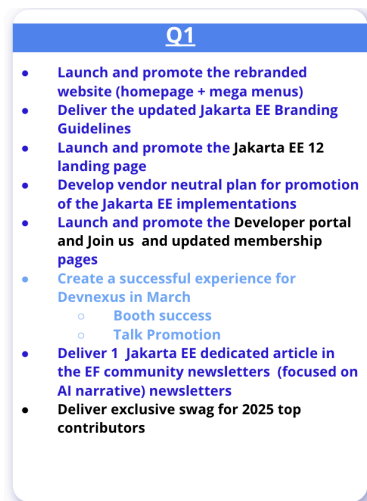

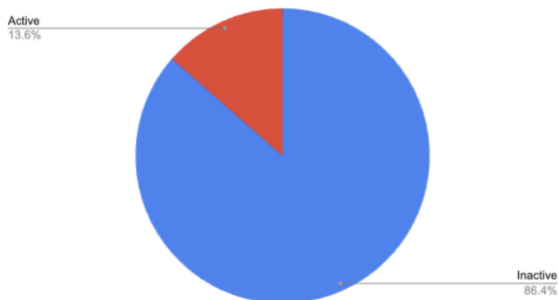

Jakarta EE Membership Fees and Charter update

- Tanja suggests postponing this discussion. So far we have the following proposals:
 - EF proposal: Membership fees change to Euros, which includes about 15% increase
 - IBM proposal: Membership fees change to Euros with various changes on the membership fees (e.g. decrease for Strategic members, increase for Participant members)
 - Another option that was mentioned is Membership fees change to Euros, but the the fee value approximately stay the same (using avg. 2025 exchange rate)
 - Fee increase is discussed separately and afterwards
