## Jakarta EE 11 Update

### October 29 Update

- The Jakarta EE 11 Web and Platform TCK will consist of
  1. A sufficiently complete, refactored, Web and Platform TCK using the new system devised by the Platform TCK project team.
    - a. An exclusion list of tests the Platform TCK project deems can be safely excluded without sacrificing compatibility coverage given the other provisions of this plan.
  2. A version of the Jakarta EE 10 TCK designed to certify EE 11 compatible implementations on the required Java versions for Jakarta EE 11.
    - a. An exclusion list of tests the Platform TCK project deems can be safely excluded without sacrificing compatibility coverage given the other provisions of this plan.
  3. A TCK User Guide describing how to run the previous two parts.
- Taken together, the two exclusion lists provide an acceptable amount of compatibility assertion so that voting members can feel confident in voting to approve the EE 11 Web and Platform ballots.
- Finally, the Jakarta EE Platform and Platform TCK projects commit to delivering a version of the Jakarta EE 11 Web and Platform TCK that does not require the use of a Jakarta EE 10 TCK as the first deliverable after the delivery of EE 11.
