We agree with infrastructure donation if it's based on Open Source Software to allow contribution. 2. We recommend an opt-in approach for badges to be shown in the system as part of end-user data. 3. As a marketing Committee, we can help with the design of the overall system. Still, we strongly suggest relying on the specification leads and committers to provide the system's content (questions and answers). 4. In favor of vendor neutrality and keeping the scope of the tests to Jakarta EE content only, the Jakarta EE badging system shouldn't require nor provide server-specific configuration and administration for end-user who take the tests.
